Official Ballot Instructions:

- Each candidate should be ranked only once.
- You may NOT assign the same numeric value to multiple candidates (e.g. two candidates ranked 3rd choice).
- You may NOT skip a numeric value while ranking (e.g. 1, 2, 4, 5... ← NOT allowed)
- You may write-in candidate(s) by filling out their name at the bottom of the ballot and assigning them a rank.
- Only original ballot accepted. No copies.
- Each voter is allowed 1 vote. If your choice(s) are elected with a greater number of votes than the number required, the surplus fraction of each vote received goes to the voters' second choice, third choice, etc until their single vote is used up.
